Available On-Demand with Reservationless

With the scope of business becoming increasingly international, the reach of conference communications has kept pace to span the globe. As the ability to connect with business associates, employees and other stakeholders worldwide increases, language barriers become more of a business concern. That's why Consecutive Interpretation services are available with our Reservationless audio conferencing.

This on-demand, easy-to-use service allows you to utilize the dial-out feature of Reservationless to instantly connect an interpreter to your conference. By allowing 30% of additional time after completing your thought or pausing every two to three sentences during your conference call, you allow the interpreter time to render your remarks in your participants' language. Consecutive interpretation enables your participants to listen to the proceedings in both languages, if they desire, in order to fully absorb the ideas and concepts being discussed.

GETTING STARTED

Using Reservationless-Plus Consecutive Interpretation services, available at any time, is simple. Just follow these steps and reference the language chart below.

- 1 Send an email to interpretationrequest@speakspace.com to request an interpretation access code. Please allow one business day to receive the code. You can use this code for all your Reservationless calls requiring Interpretation services.
- 2 Once your call has started, press ***1** on your phone keypad to access the Reservationless dial-out menu.
- 3 Dial +1.540.866.9011, then follow the prompts to reach the telephonic interpretation system.
- 4 Enter your access code, followed by #.
- 5 Enter the code for the language your participants need (see the chart below for a complete listing), followed by #. You may also listen to the menu of frequently requested languages and select the desired language at any time. If you need assistance, press **0** to request a customer care language representative.
- 6 When the interpreter joins the line, introduce yourself and briefly explain the situation. Press ***1** to connect both lines to the conference and instruct the interpreter when to proceed.
- 7 At the end of the call, instruct the interpreter that the call is over and disconnect.
